



Donation Guidelines

Solid Ground relies on donations from the community! Below is a list of items we do and do not accept. We always appreciate if you call ahead as we have limited storage and don't need all items at all times. Contact us at 651-846-9024 or volunteer@solidgroundmn.org.

Not sure if you should donate an item? Here's the rule of thumb we use! Ask yourself if you'd feel comfortable donating the item to a close friend or neighbor.

We generally accept:

- Alarm clocks/radios
- Bakeware (cookie sheets, pans, casserole dishes)
- Blankets & comforters (washed)
- Brooms, mops, & dust pans
- Complete sheet sets (washed)
- Cutlery (sharp knives)
- Cutting boards
- Glassware
- Hot pads and kitchen towels
- Ironing boards and irons
- Kitchenware (measuring sets, mixing bowls, can opener, colanders, cooking utensils)
- Lamps
- Laundry baskets
- Microwaves (smaller & newer)
- Pillows (new only)
- Pot and pan sets
- Sets of dishes (minimum of plates and bowls)
- Shower curtains and rings
- Silverware sets
- Swiffer sets and refills
- Toasters
- Towel sets (washed)
- Tupperware sets
- Vacuums (working only)

We DO NOT accept:

- Clothes, shoes, jewelry, and accessories
- Used toys & stuffed animals
- Used pillows
- Older computers/TVs, Cellphones
- Used/opened cleaning or toiletry products, travel-sized toiletry products
- Used brooms, brushes, or mops
- Beach towels
- Books, playing cards, & knick-knacks
- Seasonal/Holiday Items (except by approval)
- Broken, torn, or stained items of ANY kind
- Items that are not new or gently used

Furniture is accepted on a case-by-case basis and by appointment only.
